



Skypods

Available in a wide range of RAL colours choices, you can even opt for different internal and external colours on your UPVC frame.














Available in square and rectangular designs

Glass & Polycarbonate roofs


Technologies have advanced so that modern-day glass and polycarbonate roofs are more thermally-efficient today



Tinted glass reduces the intensity of the sun's rays, whilst self-cleaning glass has a coating that reacts with UV light to break down dirt and minimise the need for maintenance. Polycarbonate is probably the most affordable conservatory roof option. Great for letting in natural light, these sheets require little to no maintenance and can last for up to 15 or 20 years.


They are also available in different colours and u-values. However, they obviously do not boast the same insulating properties as some of the more robust alternatives.







